Dear Copper Harbor School Parent/Employee,

As guidance and conditions change, we may have to amend our Covid-19 policies. At this time the following are the school's policies for attendance after Covid-19 exposure or other illness. We appreciate everyone doing what they can to keep our school open and students healthy! As always, questions or concerns can be directed to the school board.

1. If a student or employee of the Copper Harbor School HAS Covid-19 or someone in their household HAS Covid-19 they must remain out of school for 10 days. If after 10 days their symptoms are gone AND they have a negative Covid-19 test (test must be taken at the end of the 10 days) they can return to school.
2. If a student or employee of the Copper Harbor School is EXPOSED to Covid-19 or someone in their household is EXPOSED they must remain out of school for 5 days. They can return to school after 5 days if they have not developed symptoms AND have a negative Covid-19 test (test must be taken at the end of the 5 days).
3. If a student or employee of the Copper Harbor School develops a new sickness and they do not know if they were exposed to Covid-19, the sick individual and members of their immediate household must remain out of school until 24 hours after symptoms have ceased AND the sick individual has a negative Covid-19 test (if subsequent members of the family become sick then the household will remain at home until all sick individuals are symptom free for 24 hours and have a negative Covid-19 test).

We will accept Covid-19 test results from doctor's offices and home (rapid) tests. Rapid tests are available at WalMart and Walgreens in Houghton.

In all cases Ms. Jill will work with parents to arrange material for kids to work from home.
